## Lakeshore Drive Weekend Closure

New Orleans, LA – Lakeshore Drive will be closed to vehicle traffic between Seabrook and Canal Boulevard from Friday, September 25<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 PM through Monday, September 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 AM. The roadway will be open to pedestrians and bicyclists. Lakefront residents will be allowed to pass as needed for access to their homes, and boaters will be allowed to pass through to the boat launches. Lakeshore Drive from Canal Boulevard westward to West End Boulevard will remain open, providing access to the Lakefront and restaurants in that area. This closure is being done in accordance with the city of New Orleans and local health officials who have stated the city will remain under Phase 2 restrictions. We will revise the closures once an announcement is made on Phase 3.
